I was born in Sofia, Bulgaria. After finishing my medical studies and defending my PhD thesis in immunology in Prague, I spent 18 months as a post-doc at the Department of Transplantation Immunology, CLB (now Sanquin) in Amsterdam. Since 2001, I am head of the Department of Immunogenetics at the Institute for Clinical and Experimental Medicine (IKEM),

supporting an intensive organ transplantation programme and the Czech Stem Cell Donor Registry (in Prague). In 2012 I became assistant professor in medical immunology. Besides teaching immunology and immunogenetics, in the recent years I was involved in the organisation of various educational workshops for HLA laboratories in the Czech Republic and Central Europe. In collaboration with colleagues from Austria and other countries, we organised the 25th EFI Conference in 2011 and fourteen East-West Immunogenetics Conferences (2006 - 2020). I was member of the organising committee of the 15th International Summer School on Immunogenetics (2021) held recently on line. Currently I am member of the Education committee of EFI. I hope to be helpful in coordinating educational activities in EFI, making a liaison between the EFI Board and the organising committees of regional conferences.
